Commencement exercises for the fourteenth graduating class of Southern Illinois University School of Medicine will be held Saturday, May 28. Sixty-eight new physicians will graduate during the 2 p.m. ceremonies, which will be held at the Sangamon State University Auditorium in Springfield.

Robert G. Petersdorf, M.D., president and chief executive officer of the Washington, D.C.-based Association of American Medical Colleges, will deliver the convocation address. Petersdorf has served as vice chancellor for Health Sciences and dean of the University of California at San Diego School of Medicine; president of Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston, Mass.; and chairman of medicine at the University of Washington School of Medicine at Seattle. He has edited "Harrison's Principles of Internal Medicine" for the past 20 years.

J. William Roddick, Jr., M.D., dean of students, will present the class for degrees. SIU President John C. Guyon, Ph.D., will confer the degrees, while Richard H. Moy, M.D., dean and provost of the School, will award diplomas.

It has become customary for the graduates to honor three of their instructors by selecting them to participate in the ceremony. The class of 1988 has chosen J. Kevin Dorsey, M.D., Ph.D., assistant professor of medicine, who will deliver the invocation; Terry A. Travis, M.D., professor of psychiatry, who will read the Hippocratic oath; and Randy A. Kienstra, M.D., associate professor of pediatrics, who will hood the graduates.

The class also has selected J. Hurley Myers, Ph.D., associate professor of physiology, as the Carbondale Teacher of the Year for his contributions during their first year.
