## SOUTHERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

### **Medical Students:**

284 current students -- 20 (7%) minority; 138 (49%) women  
1,711 graduates -- 141 (9%) minority; 573 (33%) women  
1,197 graduates in practice -- 519 (43%) in Illinois; 631 (53%) in primary care

### **Residents:**

1,321 residents and fellows have completed training  
264 current residents and fellows are in training (includes 52 in affiliates)

### **MEDPREP: (Medical/Dental Education Preparatory Program)**

952 MEDPREP alumni -- 741 (78%) minority; 511 (54%) women  
71 current MEDPREP students -- 67 (94%) minority; 46 (65%) women

### **Graduate Programs:**

8 Master's degrees awarded in education (joint program)  
2 candidates currently enrolled  
29 Doctoral and 67 Master's degrees in molecular biology, microbiology & biochemistry  
32 Doctoral and 28 Master's candidates currently enrolled  
33 Doctoral and 9 Master's degrees awarded in pharmacology  
5 Doctoral and 4 Master's candidates currently enrolled  
41 Doctoral and 78 Master's degrees awarded in physiology  
8 Doctoral and 12 Master's candidates currently enrolled

**Research:** 171 active research projects; \$17.6 million of active research funding  
(from outside sources--as of 6/30/01)\*

**Annual Fiscal Budget:** \$97.9M (million) -- \$42.0M state appropriations;  
\$3.9M tuition; \$12.1M grants/contracts; \$21.8M clinical overhead;  
\$13.3M self-supporting activities; \$4.8M indirect costs (FY02 as of 7/01)

**Library:** 148,734 volumes, 3,346 audiovisual titles and 1,159 periodicals

**Continuing Education:** 63 programs with 3,767 registrants (FY01)

**Patient Visits:** 278,585 (FY01); 292,515 projected for FY02  
Unduplicated patients served: 89,907 (FY01); 92,604 projected for FY02

**Clinical Outreach:** 81 outreach programs in 53 Illinois communities

**Memorial Medical Center:** 562 beds; 21,105 inpatients;  
450,168 outpatient visits and 49,322 emergency department visits (FY01)

**St. John's Hospital:** 734 beds; 21,388 discharge totals; 166,838 outpatient  
registrations and 51,764 emergency room registrations (projected for FY02)
