## SOUTHERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

### **Medical Students:**

289 current students -- 23 (8%) minority; 150 (52%) women  
1,847 graduates -- 152 (8%) minority; 633 (34%) women  
1,458 graduates in practice -- 622 (43%) in Illinois; 745 (51%) in primary care

### **Residents:**

1,471 residents and fellows completed training  
256 current residents and fellows in training (includes 52 in affiliates)

### **MEDPREP: (Medical/Dental Education Preparatory Program)**

1,015 MEDPREP alumni -- 819 (80.7%) minority; 550 (54.2%) women  
85 current MEDPREP students -- 77 (96%) minority; 57 (71%) women

### **Graduate Programs:**
