### Medical Students:

288 current students -- 27 (9%) minority; 151 (52%) women  
1,919 graduates -- 154 (8%) minority; 669 (34.8%) women  
1,495 graduates in practice -- 634 (42%) in Illinois; 738 (49%) in primary care

### Residents:

1,552 residents and fellows completed training  
250 current residents and fellows in training (includes 48 in affiliates)

### MEDPREP: (Medical/Dental Education Preparatory Program)

1,062 MEDPREP alumni -- 844 (79.5%) minority; 585 (55.1%) women  
66 current MEDPREP students -- 63 (95.7%) minority; 51 (73.9%) women
