### Medical Students:

289 current students -- 41 (14%) minority; 154 (53%) women  
2,061 graduates -- 168 (8%) minority; 743 (36%) women  
1,571 graduates in practice -- 671 (43%) in Illinois; 754 (48%) in primary care

### Residents:

1,687 residents and fellows completed training  
272 current residents and fellows in training (includes 56 in affiliates)

### MEDPREP: (Medical/Dental Education Preparatory Program)

1,129 MEDPREP alumni -- 908 (80.4%) minority; 635 (56.2%) women  
67 current MEDPREP students -- 65 (97%) minority; 49 (73.1%) women
