### Medical Students:

288\*\* current students -- 25 (9%) minority; 142 (49%) women  
1,847\*\* graduates -- 152 (8%) minority; 633 (34%) women  
1,224 graduates in practice -- 535 (44%) in Illinois; 651 (53%) in primary care

### Residents:

1,441 residents and fellows have completed training  
258 current residents and fellows are in training (includes 51 in affiliates)

### MEDPREP: (Medical/Dental Education Preparatory Program)

1,010 MEDPREP alumni -- 824 (81.6%) minority; 568 (56.2%) women  
85 current MEDPREP students -- 82 (96.5%) minority; 59 (69.4%) women

\$13.8M self-supporting activities; \$3.5M indirect costs (FY03 as of 7/02)

**Library:** 153,263 volumes, 3,348 audiovisual titles, 1,178 periodicals and  
4,800 special collections

**Continuing Education:** 65 programs with 3,535 registrants (FY03)

**Patient Clinic Visits:** 284,546 (FY02); 313,000 projected for FY03

**Memorial Medical Center:** 562 beds; 20,539 inpatients;
