### Medical Students:

290 current students \*\* -- 41 (14%) minority; 151 (52%) women  
2,058 graduates \*\* -- 165 (8%) minority; 742 (36%) women  
1,509 graduates in practice -- 647 (43%) in Illinois; 740 (49%) in primary care

### Residents:

1,685 residents and fellows completed training  
273 current residents and fellows in training (includes 55 in affiliates)

### MEDPREP: (Medical/Dental Education Preparatory Program)

1,093 MEDPREP alumni -- 873 (79.9%) minority; 606 (55.4%) women  
73 current MEDPREP students -- 72 (98.6%) minority; 59 (80.8%) women
