Medical Students:

287 current students -- 25 (9%) minority; 141 (49%) women
1,778 graduates -- 146 (8%) minority; 604 (34%) women
1,197 graduates in practice -- 519 (43%) in Illinois; 631 (53%) in primary care

Residents:

1,403 residents and fellows have completed training
263 current residents and fellows are in training (includes 51 in affiliates)

MEDPREP: (Medical/Dental Education Preparatory Program)

985 MEDPREP alumni -- 771 (78%) minority; 532 (54%) women
74 current MEDPREP students -- 70 (95%) minority; 49 (66%) women
