Medical Students:

284 current students -- 20 (7%) minority; 138 (49%) women
1,711 graduates -- 141 (9%) minority; 573 (33%) women
1,161 graduates in practice -- 504 (43%) in Illinois; 608 (52%) in primary care

Residents:

1,290 residents and fellows have completed training
267 current residents and fellows are in training (includes 52 in affiliates)

950 MEDPREP alumni -- 739 (78%) minority; 509 (54%) women
73 current MEDPREP students -- 69 (95%) minority; 48 (66%) women
