**Medical Students:**

291 current students -- 49 (17%) minority; 154 (53%) women  
2,130 graduates -- 180 (8.4%) minority; 781 (36.6%) women  
1,644 graduates in practice -- 707 (43%) in Illinois; 793 (48%) in primary care

**Residents:**

273 current residents and fellows in training (includes 56 in affiliates)  
1,754 residents and fellows completed training

**MEDPREP:** (Medical/Dental Education Preparatory Program)

70 current MEDPREP students -- 67 (95.7%) minority; 49 (70%) women
