

Senior Clinical Competency Examination (SCCX) Grade Review Process

After the Senior Clinical Competency Examination (SCCX) is scored, the Clinical Competency Examination (CCX) Committee will review the aggregate data and establish the pass level for the examination. Students who receive a failing grade on the SCCX will **automatically** have their examination performance reviewed in detail. The outcome of this review will be considered the final grade and will be reported to the student and submitted to the Student Progress Committee.

Students with failing grades will be given the opportunity to meet with the chair of the CCX Committee, or another committee member, to discuss the weaknesses reflected in their SCCX performance.
