

SIU School of Medicine Year Three Curriculum -- Academic Year 2008-2009

A series of rotations through major clerkship areas for a breadth of specialty and primary-care oriented clinical experiences, as well as a two-week Doctoring experience focusing on the physician-patient relationship. Faculty cross clinical discipline areas and will include basic scientists. Learning activities include: direct patient contact in patient care teams, with continued emphasis on basic science concepts and skills for life-long learning. At the conclusion of this year, students should have broad exposure to be able to develop career choices.
