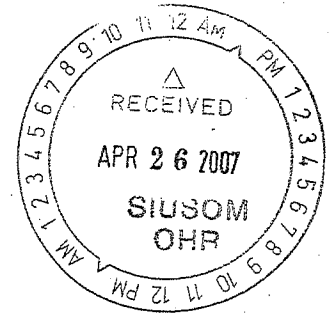


POSITION DESCRIPTION

RANK: Assistant /Associate Professor of Clinical Medicine

DEPARTMENT/DIVISION: Internal Medicine/Pulmonary/Critical Care Medicine

GENERAL DUTIES:

This position has the responsibility to participate in and develop the Division of Pulmonary Medicine/Critical Care Medicine in the Department of Internal Medicine and to participate as a full time faculty member in the Departmental and Medical School activities.

CHARACTERISTIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES;

- I. Administration 0%
- II. Teaching 30%
  - A. Residency Programs
    - 1. Prepare and present lectures, seminars, conferences and rounds for resident house staff members in the Department of medicine and other Departments.
    - 2. Attend on Internal Medicine and Pulmonary Medicine.
    - 3. Individual instruction for residents in the form of inpatient or outpatient consultations.
    - 4. Participate in the pulmonary fellowship programs.
  - B. Medical School Program
    - 1. Sequence I - Participate in the organization and presentation of material in the Pulmonary Medicine block as needed.
    - 2. Sequence II - Lecture, present conferences and present for Sequence II and participate in Introduction to Clinical Medicine.
    - 3. Sequence III - Seminars, conferences and individual student contact during patient consultations on various clerkships.
    - 4. Sequence IV - Organize Division electives and participate in the forms of lectures, seminars, rounds, etc., for those students on Pulmonary Medicine electives.
  - C. Continuing Medical Education and other Medical Training
    - 1. Individual, Personal: - Attend and participate in local, regional, national and international meetings in Medicine and Pulmonary Medicine/Critical Care.

2. Divisional: Participate in Pulmonary Medicine rounds and conferences.
3. Departmental: Prepare conferences for the Department of Medicine and other Departments.
4. Medical School: -Lecture and attend conferences at hospitals in communities of Central and Southern Illinois.
5. Other: Prepare conferences and lectures presented to nursing and other paramedical personnel at hospitals in the community.

III. Research and Advance Training 25%

As defined by pulmonary division, individual interest and department policy. This may include the development of an external grant application with expectation of funding during the subsequent fiscal year.

IV. Service 45%

A. Hospital and Regional Services

Participate in hospital committees. Administrative and teaching responsibilities affiliated with regional hospitals.

B. Professional Services

1. Consultant for inpatient and outpatient as requested by SIU full-time and clinical faculty, house staff and community physicians.
2. Develop and maintain professional practice in accordance with departmental policy.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- I. Graduate of accredited medical school program.
  - II. Graduate of formal specialty training program in Pulmonary Medicine.
  - III. Diplomate of Board of Internal Medicine with eligibility for certification in critical care medicine and pulmonary medicine.
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
