GENERAL DUTIES

This position will report to the Program Director of the SIU-Springfield Center for Family Medicine. Duties will include a combination of patient care, research and teaching in the residency program including inpatient medicine and obstetrics.

Teaching (20%)

- A. Provide supervision of family practice residents in the outpatient setting.
- B. Conduct and supervise inpatient-teaching rounds.
- C. Assist in the planning and presentation of family practice conferences.
- D. Assist with the teaching in the residency and undergraduate programs.

Research/Academic Activities (5%)

- A. Conduct research in areas of particular interest.
- B. Develop essential research skills including conceptual development and critical review of existing knowledge, project design and data analysis.
- C. Attendance at national professional meetings.

Service (75%)

- A. Provide direct patient care to own panel of patients at the Center and at other off-site clinics as appropriate.
- B. Participate in family practice medicine and obstetrical call.
- D. Serve on the Center-wide Committees, e.g., Recruitment, Orientation, Quality Improvement, Advanced OB, and others as assigned.
