

**PROGRESS NOTE 1—JK 8 months old**

**6/15/02**  
06:50 am

**S:** Still wheezing, but mom says he's better. One episode of cough related emesis last night.

**O:** pulse 149 resp:42 BP =70-90/45-60 Afebrile Tm 39 x 24 hrs .weight=4.0 kg  
I/O = 130 po + 240 IV/ 300 Sats 92% on 1.5 lpm O2

Gen: Awake alert and consoled with mom.

Skin: Pink no rashes, no acrocyanosis

Lungs: tachypnea, bibasilar rales and end expiratory wheezes. No retractions or accessory muscle use.

CV: Tachycardia, S1/S2 nl. No audible murmur.

Abd: BS+, soft, no masses. Liver edge palpable 1 cm. Below R. costal margin

Labs: BMP pending

**A/P:**

1. Asthma exacerbation---likely secondary to CHF and/or pneumonia. Plan to continue albuterol nebs every 2 hours and pulmicort nebs twice daily. Will not start systemic steroids unless condition worsens.
2. Pneumonia—likely bacterial. Day 2 unasyn in progress. Will repeat a CXR today to rule out worsening infiltrative changes. If fever persists or O2 requirement increases will want to repeat CBC and/or blood culture.
3. history of VSD repair age 3 months—no evidence of CHF on exam. Will continue telemetry and observations.
4. FEN—taking less than half maintenance orally. Will not push due to tachypnea. IVF's D5 1/3 NS at ½ maintenance. If respiratory rate increases or vomiting becomes a problem will make NPO and increase IVF's to maintenance.

**Addendum:**

**S:** Emesis has persisted throughout the day. Mom reports persistent vomiting with cough today.

**O:** Afebrile since 7 am. VSS. Sats 93-94% on 1.5 lpm O2 resp: 40's/min

Lungs: Rales persist bilaterally, few wheezes, no retractions, good air exchange

CV: No murmur

BMP: Na 134; K 4.0; Cl: 99; CO2 20; BUN 8; creatinine 0.7; glucose 84

1. Asthma exacerbation—little change since this morning. Continue O2, albuterol nebs q 2 hours and bid pulmicort. Will continue nebs until able to wean off of O2
2. Pneumonia – d3 unasyn now. Will continue current management unless deteriorates. If problems will check CXR.
3. H/O VSD repair---no problems on exam
4. FEN—poor po intake today and continued vomiting and tachypnea. Will make NPO and increase IVF's to maintenance. Will order BMP for tomorrow morning.
