Vacation Usage Policy

Per the policy below, you may only take vacation listed during the following rotations. There are blackouts of July, first week of October for PRITE, first week of February for CSVE, MANDT training week in August.

Vacation periods are to be submitted by May 30th, 2010 for the coming academic year.

1st Year Residents

Primary Care Rotations (4 months) – No Vacation

Adult Inpatient Psychiatry (8 months) – 3 weeks, only 2 weeks in one month the 3rd week will have to be in another month.

2nd Year Residents (3rd Year Med/Psych)

Med/Psych and Psych- Adult Inpatient Psychiatry (3 months) – 3 weeks, only 2 weeks in one month the 3rd week will have to be in another month.

CAP (2 months) – 1 week

Med/Psych - CAP (1 months) – 1 week

Center for Alzheimers Disease (2 weeks) – no vacation

C/L Rotation (2 months) – 1 week

Community Psychiatry (2 ½ month Rotation) – 2 weeks

ECT/TMS (1 month) – 1 week

McFarland (1 month) – 1 week

Neurology Rotation (2 months) – 1 week

Med/Psych - Outpatient (4 months) – 3 weeks in either 3rd year or 4th year (not both)

Substance Abuse (1 month) – No Vacation

3rd Year Residents (4th Year Med/Psych Residents)

Outpatient (12 months) – 3 weeks

Med/Psych - Outpatient (8 months) – 3 weeks in either 3rd year or 4th year (not both)

4th Year Residents (5th Year Med/Psych)

Adult Inpatient Psychiatry (1 month) – 1 week

Electives (1 month) – 1 week

McFarland (1 month) – 1 week

Med/Psych - Center for Alzheimers Disease (2 weeks) – no vacation

Med/Psych - Community Psychiatry (1 ½ month Rotation) – 2 weeks

Med/Psych - ECT/TMS (1 month) – 1 week
