

EVALUATION PROCESS

Your final evaluation is determined by the following components:

NBME - Must score a 62 or above. If student fails on first attempt, they will be required to retake the NBME. If student fails on second attempt, the Department of Psychiatry will recommend a remediation plan to the Student Progress Committee.

Clinical Exams - If a student fails two of the three exams, he/she will remediate a case. If the student fails the case on the second attempt, the Department of Psychiatry will recommend a remediation plan to the Student Progress Committee.

Clinical Evaluations - Must have overall satisfactory evaluations.

Noncognitive – Any early concern forms may impact your final evaluation.
