

In-Patient Weekend Rounds

Part of your assignment in Psychiatry may include patient rounding on Saturday mornings. This includes the following services:

- MMC5A adult inpatient
- St. John's inpatient
- Consult Liaison
- Community Support Network (see note below)

On most occasions, you will be rounding with an attending on Saturday mornings. You should contact the resident assigned to the service on Friday afternoon to make arrangements to meet the attending on Saturday. If you do not know who the assigned resident is, contact Vivian Smith at 545-7627. Resident pager numbers are listed on the department phone listing.

It will be your responsibility to obtain a summary of the service from the resident. This summary should include patient names, room numbers, diagnoses and Saturday treatment plans. You will be expected to communicate this information to the attending on Saturday.

You will not have Saturday rounds the 3rd and 6th week of your clerkship rotation unless you are making up time missed. These are test weeks.

Below is an example of what a patient summary may look like.
