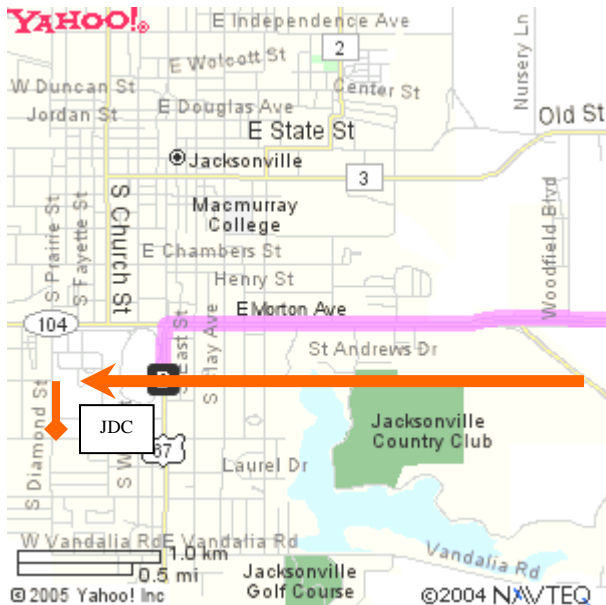
Patients: The student will be asked to evaluate several individuals with developmental disabilities during the rotation. A progress note in SOAP format will be required with each patient contact. Prior to each Wednesday, the student will be provided a topic(s) with the expectation that they come prepared to discuss the topic and then evaluate patients relevant to the particular area of interest for that week.

Observation by Attending Psychiatrist: All patient interviews will be observed by the Attending Psychiatrist and feedback will be provided.

Skill Acquisition:

1. Become more familiar with assessing individuals with developmental disabilities.
2. Learn to gather information from various sources and by observing the patient.
3. Focus on differential diagnoses of behavioral exacerbation.
4. Learn to seek medical and/or environmental factors contributing to behavioral changes.
5. Be able to provide recommendations for each person assessed.

1. Take 72 W to Jacksonville
2. Take exit 68 (1st Jacksonville exit) into Jacksonville which will go past the prison.
3. Turn right on Morton Street.
4. Continue on Morton for 3 or 4 stoplights).
5. Turn left on Diamond Street (McDonalds on Corner to right).
6. Take 2nd entrance into JDC.
