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
Memorial Partial Hospital Program is a program that provides alternative care to patients who would typically be admitted to an inpatient facility for psychiatric care. The program provides services to patients in an outpatient setting where they are discharged daily around 1:30. The program runs for 10 – 12 days with most patients.

The program director will arrive on the unit at 7:45 a.m., unless otherwise specified, with rounds report from 8:00-1:30. It is expected that students will see their assigned patients and write progress notes daily. Students will be involved in rounding Monday through Friday.

While on the service, students will be expected to attend family sessions conducted by therapists with their patients' families whenever it does not conflict with other educational experiences. Individual arrangements must be made with the assigned psychotherapists for each family.

It is expected that students will read on psychiatry issues most directly related to their current assigned cases. Most common psychiatric diagnoses seen in the program include:

- major depressive disorder
- bi-polar disorder
