The position is also responsible for instruction of students, residents and other allied health professionals in both Anna and Carbondale as well as participation in clinical and research services.

Qualified applicants must have completed four years of AOA or ACGME approved postgraduate training with specialization in psychiatry, must be board certified in general psychiatry, must be eligible for licensure as an M.D. or D.O. in the State of Illinois and have substantial experience directing a clinical psychiatric service.
