## Near-Miss Awards Call for Applications – Fall 2021

Due date: 4:00 PM on Friday, October 29, 2021

## IN FAIRNESS TO ALL--LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

The goal of the Near-Miss funding program is to support the improvement of grant applications that were submitted to Federal-level agencies, but were not funded. These applications are reviewed by an *ad hoc* review committee appointed by the ADR. - I. Submission of Applications: To apply for Near-Miss funding, submit <u>one</u> PDF file by email to grants@siumed.edu by the due date above.
  Assemble the pdf components in the following order:
  - A. Near-Miss Cover Page
  - B. Application introduction (limit 2 pages maximum) explaining how the PI will use Near-Miss funds to address the concerns raised in the critique.
  - C. A one-year itemized budget for a maximum of \$25,000 (1 page), plus budget justification (1 page).
  - D. The critique for the original application dated on or after October 29, 2020.
  - E. The original application.
