

# Near-Miss Awards Call for Applications – Fall 2021

**Due date: 4:00 PM on Friday, October 29, 2021**

**IN FAIRNESS TO ALL--LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

The goal of the Near-Miss funding program is to support the improvement of grant applications that were submitted to Federal-level agencies, but were not funded. These applications are reviewed by an *ad hoc* review committee appointed by the ADR. Full guidelines are available at <https://www.siumed.edu/adr/near-miss-awards.html>.

In brief:

- I. **Submission of Applications:** To apply for Near-Miss funding, submit **one** PDF file by email to [grants@siu.edu](mailto:grants@siu.edu) by the due date above.  
**Assemble the pdf components in the following order:**
  - A. Near-Miss Cover Page
  - B. Application introduction (limit 2 pages maximum) explaining how the PI will use Near-Miss funds to address the concerns raised in the critique.
  - C. A one-year itemized budget for a maximum of \$25,000 (1 page), plus budget justification (1 page).
  - D. **The critique for the original application dated on or after October 29, 2020.**
  - E. The original application.
