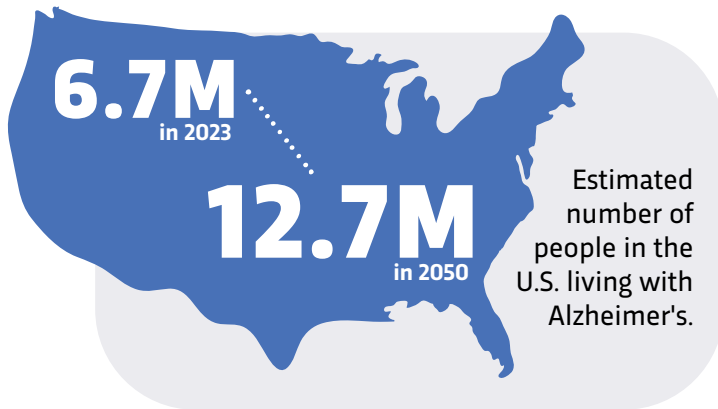


ALZHEIMER'S FACT SHEET



A broad look at the prevalence, risk, and cost of dementia in our nation and our community.



Women are twice as likely as men to develop dementia.

Black individuals are twice as likely as white individuals to develop dementia.

AT RISK**

1 in 9 persons over the age of 65 have Alzheimer's or related dementia.

30% of dementia patients rely on three or more unpaid caregivers.

Alzheimer's

- Vascular
- Lewy Body
- Frontotemporal
- Other

is the prevalent dementia subtype, accounting for roughly 60-70% of all cases. Vascular dementia accounts for up to 15-20%.
