MISCELLANEOUS

Absences: Y2 Absence Guidelines

<u>Unplanned:</u> If you are missing a required activity (tutor group, doctoring event, exam, etc.) due to illness or emergencies it should be reported through the Sick Hotline by calling **217-545-SICK (7425)**.

<u>Planned:</u> Absences from required activities should be reported by completing the online Planned Absence Request Form: <u>Link to Absence Request Form (new version)</u>

COVID Guidelines: COVID Exposures / Self-Monitoring, students are required to self-monitor per posted recommended guidelines. Students must self-report exposures or positive symptoms to the Employee Health Nurse (217-492-2446) and Haneme Idrizi, MD (Student Affairs Office) for further instructions. We ask that students whom are asked to quarantine (Stay at Home Orders) complete the absence form for documentation. Extended Leave or Absences must be reported and approved by Student Affairs. COVID Updates are routinely posted on the <u>Hive Intranet for SIU Medicine Employees</u>

Mailboxes: Located in the Student Business Office, your mailbox should be checked daily and cleaned out regularly. Mailboxes are considered the private domain of an individual student. Reviewing other people's mail is a breach of professional behavior and may be reported as such.

Lockers: Lockers are available for use during Year 2; however, students must provide their own locks and are responsible for clearing them out at the end of Year 2. Lockers are located in the 2nd floor southwest corridor. Before choosing a locker, please see Terra Collins in Student Affairs.

Medical First Aid Station: The Alumni Society Board of Governors has funded medical supplies for all classes. Located in the student lounge, this station is stocked with an assortment of medications, bandages, dressings, and other supplies. Medications have been individually packaged for your convenience and safety. Please feel free to use any supplies you need.
