





ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT

Remediation in Year 2

- Knowledge
 - Remediation period (June)
 - Units may be remediated simultaneously
 - Discipline Specific remediation can be required
 - Success on remediation exams
 - 75.0% or class mean % of EOU-MCQ, whichever is lowest
- Clinical Skills and Reasoning
 - Usually right after completion of unit; may include summer
- Non-cognitive Behavior and Professionalism



 Radiology Resource Sessions for each block: Hematology, Immunology, Infection (HII); Cardiovascular, Renal Respiratory (CRR); Neuromuscular, Behavior (NMB); and Endocrine, Reproduction, and Gastrointestinal (ERG).

Radiology TEACHES




- Radiology Resource Sessions for each block will focus on different imaging modalities (i.e. plain film, CT, US, and MRI).
- Specific focus on Normal Anatomy with different imaging modalities
- Basic pathology will also be covered with the radiology resource sessions.



 Radiology Resource Sessions will feature prerecorded lectures available on D2L plus a Question and Answer session (in person if possible) with a Radiology Resident at the end of each block prior to the test for the unit. In addition, there is a separate in person review (if possible) with a radiology resident to go over questions with regard to the test.



- Recommended resources
 - <u>Learning Radiology</u> by *William Herring*Hard copy and electronic versions (via ClinicalKey) available at library.



Also <u>radiopaedia.org</u> is a very good free online resource





Radiology TEACHES

- Online portal that uses case vignettes integrated with American College of Radiology (ACR) clinical decision support or ACR Select.
- Learner receives evidence-based feedback regarding appropriateness of imaging for given clinical situations, appropriate use of intravenous contrast, cost of imaging examinations, and awareness of radiation exposure for imaging modalities.



- Pre-test and post-test assessment
- In addition, there are 9 modules which are incorporated into the 4 different blocks.
- Modules consist of multiple choice questions with links to appropriate articles and imaging resources.



- Each question also has an "Ask the Radiologist a Question" link.
- There are four "Radiologist Champions" to answer e-mail questions. All champions are former SIU medical students:

Matt Abell MD Scott Long MD

Patrick Rhoades MD Britta Varney MD

Each block has composite of approximately 100 questions



- HII Block: Pre-Test Assessment Module, Choosing Wisely, and General Simulation Cases
- CRR Block: Internal Medicine, Family and Community
- NMB Block: Neuro, Psychiatry, and Pediatric
- ERG: Surgery, OB/Gyn, and Post-Assessment



- Year Two students will receive an e-mail from Shannon Boxman with account and log in instructions for the Radiology-TEACHES online portal.
- Students can then work at their own pace on the modules. Even though the modules have been selected for individual blocks, it would be possible to work ahead.
- There is no separate evaluation or test for Radiology-TEACHES material other than the assessments built into the online Radiology-TEACHES portal.
- In addition, all material for the Radiology-TEACHES is recommended to be completed but not required.
