The Center for Disease Control has defined a culture of safety as the shared commitment of management and employees to ensure the safety of the work environment. The safety of patients is paramount. A culture of safety acknowledges the inevitability of error, and proactively seeks to identify latent threats. Characteristics of such a culture include: Environment where individuals are confident that they can report errors or close calls ("near misses") without fear of retribution; Collaboration across the ranks to seek solutions to system vulnerabilities; Demonstrated willingness to direct resources to address safety concern. An organization with a culture of safety encourages acknowledgment of error and actively attributes such primarily to process/system failures.
